
How to Obtain an Unofficial Academic Record in myZou Current and Former MU students

Note: These instructions only apply to **students who apply for graduate admissions and have access to myZou**. Former students (who attended MU from 2006 and beyond) should still have access to **myZou** even after leaving MU. If you do not have access to **myZou**, please contact the Graduate School for assistance. The Graduate School can only provide unofficial academic records to current or former MU students applying for graduate admission at MU; we are not authorized to provide these documents for any other purpose.

A **student academic profile** is a copy of your academic history at Mizzou, including information on courses, grades, test scores, degrees, and day/month of your birth. This profile is what some might refer to as an unofficial transcript. Request an academic profile in myZou and a PDF will be sent to your official MU email account.

To obtain the **student academic profile**, log on to <u>myZou</u>, and navigate to **Student Center > Academic Records > Req Student Academic Profile**. Click on the **Submit** button to request. Your student academic profile will be sent to your university's email address.



If accepted by an academic program, MU students do not have to provide an official transcript to the Graduate Admissions office. Grades and degree(s) will be verified in myZou.
